Venice, May 25. N. S. Ratisbonia, June 4. Monsieur Spankeim, the Resident of the States General, presented a scood Monorial to the Imperial Diet this morning, to quicken such Princes and States as have hitherto been backward in sending their Contingents to the Army which is to be kept on foot by the Empire. On the 19th past 4 Bavarian Bertalions of Foot arrived at Weicht, a Castle over against this Town, where they encamped the same night, and the next morning they marched towards Amberg, to join the Bavarian Troops that retired thither after their Deseat at Krosenzee. The Count de Monasterole want the same day to Amberg, being to command that Detachment in the room of General Mast: A sother small Body of Bavarians continues at Kelbaim, and their main Army, with a strack the Circle of Franconia, as soon as the Elector arrives in their Army from Manich, where he was on the 2d Instant.
