### ROAD HAULAGE WAGES COUNCIL.

The Road Haulage Wages Council hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour and National Service proposals (1) for the amendment of the Road Haulage Wages Council

Wages Regulation (No. 2) Order 1949 (Order R.H.(30)) as amended by the Road Haulage Wages Council Wages Regulation (No. 3) Order 1949 (Order R.H.(32)) and by the Road Haulage Wages Council Wages Regulation Order 1950 (Order R.H. (36)) and (2) for the revocation of Order R.H.(36) relating to statutory minimum remuneration.
