## COUNTY BOROUGH OF SUNDERLAND.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930—SECTION 102.

THE ISLE OF WIGHT (AREAS OF SPECIAL CONTROL OF ADVERTISEMENTS) ORDER, 1950.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Local Government and Planning in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 31 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, and Regulation 10 of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations, 1948, has approved with modifications an Order defining as Areas of Special Control for the purposes of those Regulations, areas of land situate in the administrative County of the Isle of Wight and forming parts of the Boroughs of Newport and Ryde, the Urban Districts of Cowes, Sandown-Shanklin and Ventnor, and the Rural District of the Isle of Wight and described in the Schedule hereto which land is shown edged red and left uncoloured on the map referred to in the Order. The Order comes into force on the 31st day of July, 1951.

The whole of the Urban District of Sandown-Shanklin *except* those portions hatched orange or coloured pink on the plan accompanying the Order.

*In the Urban District of Ventnor, I.W.*

The whole of the Urban District of Ventnor *except* those portions hatched yellow or coloured pink on the plan accompanying the Order.
