LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

Essex Rivers Catchment Board.

Maldon, Wivenhoe and Clacton Internal Drainage District.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming with a minor modification, a Scheme submitted to him by the Essex Rivers Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of that Act, making provision for the following matters:—

1. The alteration of the boundaries of the Maldon, Wivenhoe and Clacton Internal Drainage District.

2. Matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty-five days from the date of this Notice a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial, praying that the Order shall be subject to special Parliamentary procedure.
