PRESENT

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 9th day of November, 1951, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for altering the boundaries of the parish of Abington, the parish of Weston Favell, and the parish of Saint Matthew, Northampton, all in the diocese of Peterborough, and for constituting part of the parish of Abington and part of the parish of Weston Favell a new parish. parish.

" SCHEME.

"Whereas we, the Church Commissioners, are satisfied (1) that it is desirable that the boundaries of the parish of Abington, the parish of Weston Favell and the parish of St. Matthew, Northampton, should be altered in the manner described in Parts I and II of the subjoined Schedule, and as delineated on the map hereto annexed, and (2) that the spiritual interests of the area defined in Part III of the said Schedule and delineated on the said map would be best served by constituting it a new parish and that best served by constituting it a new parish and that a suitable endowment therefor will be provided:

"And whereas there is wifhin the area described in Part III of the said Schedule a consecrated church known as the church of Saint Alban the Martyr, Abington, which has been approved by us, the said Church Commissioners, as suitable to be the parish church of the new parish and of which the patronage belongs to the Bishop of Peterborough by virtue of an agreement in writing dated the 3rd day of August, 1951, and made pursuant to section 9 of the New Parishes Measure, 1943.

"New Absertance with the appearant of the Right."

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Spencer, Bishop of Peterborough, (in testimony whereof he has set his hand and affixed his episcopal seal to this Scheme), we, the said Church Commissioners, do humbly recommend and propose as follows, that is to say:

"1. As from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme (a) the boundaries of the said parish of Abington, the said parish of Weston Favell, and the said parish of Saint Matthew, Northampton, shall be altered in the manner described in Parts I and II of the said Schedule and delineated on the map annexed hereto, and (b) the area defined in Part III of the said Schedule, and delineated on the said map shall be a new parish. said map shall be a new parish.

"2. The church of Saint Alban the Martyr, Abington, aforesaid, shall be the parish church of the parish.

"3. The name of the parish shall be 'the parish

of Saint Alban the Martyr, Abington.'
"4. The parish shall be in the Archdeaconry of Northampton and in the rural deanery of Haddon (second deanery).

"THE SCHEDULE. "PART I.

"The territory (coloured green on the map) to be annexed to the parish of Saint Matthew, Northamp-

annexed to the parish of Saint Matthew, Normanipton:—

"All that portion of the parish of Albington which is bounded upon the northwest by the parish of Saint Matthew, Northampton, and upon the remaining sides by an imaginary line commencing at a point in the middle of Birchfield Road on the boundary which divides the parish of Saint Matthew, Northampton, from the parish of Abington and extending thence northeastwards along the middle of Birchfield Road to a point opposite to the middle of the southern end of Park Avenue North and continuing thence northwards to and along Park Avenue North thence northwards to and along Park Avenue North to the boundary which divides the parish of Abing-ton from the parish of Saint Matthew, Northampton.

"PART II.

"The territory (coloured blue on the map) to be annexed to the parish of Weston Favell:—

"All that portion of the parish of Abington which is bounded upon the northeast and southeast by the parish of Weston Favell and upon the remaining side by an imaginary line commencing at the southeastern end of the wall or fence which divides the houses and premises numbered 168 and 166 The Headlands on the boundary which divides the parish of Weston Favell from the parish of Abington and extending thence southwards along the walls or fences of the houses and premises numbered 166 to 144 The Headlands to the boundary which divides the last mentioned parishes.

"PART III.

"The territory (coloured pink on the map) com-

prising:—

"All those contiguous portions of the parishes of Abington and Weston Favell which, taken together, are bounded upon part of the west by the territory described in Part I of this Schedule and proposed to be annexed to the parish of Saint Matthew, Northampton, upon the remaining part of the west by the last mentioned parish, and by the parish of Holy Trinity, Northampton, upon the northwest by the parish of Kingsthorpe, upon the north by the extra parochial place known as Moulton Park and the parish of Weston Favell and upon the northeast partly by the last mentioned parish, and partly by the territory described in Part II of this Schedule and proposed to be annexed to the parish of Weston Favell and upon the remaining sides by an imaginary line commencing at the eastern end of the wall or fence which divides the houses and premises numfence which divides the houses and premises num-bered 144 and 142 The Headlands and continuing
