WAGES COUNCILS ACTS, 1945 TO 1948.

PIN, HOOK AND EYE, AND SNAP FASTENER WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN).

The Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour and National Service proposals for the revocation of the Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages Council (Great Britain) Wages Regulation (Holidays) Order, 1946 (Order O. (36)) and for the making of a wages regulation order relating to holidays and holiday remuneration in substitution for the provisions at present in operation.

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within 14 days from 29th February, 1951. Any such representation should be signed by the person making the same (adding his or her address) and sent to the Secretary, Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages Council (Great Britain), Ebury Bridge House, Ebury Bridge Road, London, S.W.1. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise grounds of their objections.
