THE Rural District Council of Cockermouth acting in their capacity as Coast Protection Authority, hereby give notice that they propose to make an Order applying the provisions of Section 18 of the above Act (which prohibits, save under licence, the excavation or removal of materials, other than minerals more than fifty feet below the surface, on, under or forming part of any portion of the sea shore being within the Rural District of Cockermouth or lying to seaward therefrom.)

The draft Order may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Council Offices, Grecian Villa, Cockermouth, Cumberland.

Any person may not later than 1st April, 1952, serve a notice of objection to the draft Order on the Minister of Housing and Local Government. ALTERATION OF DECLARED CALORIFIC VALUE.

NORTH Western Gas Board pursuant to the provisions of The Gas (Declaration of Calorific Value) Regulations 1949, hereby give notice that on and after the 1st day of April 1952 the declared calorific value of gas supplied from their gasworks at Amble-side shall be 475 British Thermal Units per cubic foot instead of 500 British Thermal Units per cubic foot.
