

On behalf of the Minister of Supply (hereinafter called "the Minister") I hereby give you and each of you notice:

1. That under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts and Order or some or one of them the Minister requires the rights described in the Schedule hereto.

2. That the Minister is willing to treat and agree with you and each of you according to your respective titles, estates powers and interests (if any) for the acquisition of the said rights and as to the compensation or consideration to be made to you and each of you for the diminution in the value of your respective interests in the said land ceased by such acquisition.

3. That you are hereby required to state the particulars of your respective estates and interests in the said land and of all charges and interests to which the same are subject, and of your respective claims in respect of the said acquisition which several particulars should be stated in a form of claim of which copies may be obtained on application to the Treasury Solicitor (Ref. S.C. 1209/EMC), Storey's Gate, St. James's Park, London, S.W.1.

4. That if for the space of thirty days after the service and publication of this notice you or any of you refuse or decline to treat or agree with the Minister as to the said compensation or by reason of absence are prevented from so treating or agreeing or refuse to accept such sum as shall be offered by the Minister in respect thereof the Minister may require such compensation to be settled pursuant to the provisions of the said Acts and Order or some or one of them.

THE SCHEDULE.

The following rights for the Minister and his successors in title in fee simple to the intent that the same shall be appurtenant to the neighbouring land and premises of the Minister at Summerfield in the Parish of Hartlebury in the County of Worcester and every part thereof:

(1) The right in fee simple to lay maintain renew remove and use a water pipe with the necessary manholes and apparatus on and under land in the said Parish of Hartlebury namely along the western side of a piece of open land (being Ordnance Survey Enclosure No. 105) on the north side of the roadway between Wilden Lane and Summerway Farm.

(2) The necessary rights of entry on the said land the Minister keeping the said water pipe and apparatus in good repair and making good any damage to the surface caused by the exercise of such rights.
