WHITE FISH AUTHORITY.

SEA FISH INDUSTRY ACT, 1951.

Notice of General Levy Regulations.

1. THE White Fish Authority hereby give notice that, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the above Act, it is their intention to make regulations which will come into operation on the 9th day of June 1952 and which will provide for (*inter alia*):—

(1) the payment to the Authority, by every person who purchases white fish other than shell-fish on a first-hand sale, of a levy at the rate of one halfpenny for every stone of white fish so purchased;

(2) the keeping of certain records by persons selling white fish otherwise than by retail, by persons selling white fish by retail and by fish friers;

(3) the revocation of the White Fish Authority (General Levy) Regulations 1951.

2. The draft regulations can be inspected during usual office hours at the office of the White Fish Authority at Conyngham Hall, Knaresborough, at the office of the Scottish Committee of the White Fish Authority at 17, Rutland Square, Edinburgh 1, and at the office of the Ministry of Commerce, Chichester House, Chichester Street, Belfast, Northern Ireland.

3. Copies of the draft regulations can be purchased from the White Fish Authority or from the Scottish Committee thereof at the addresses given above, at a cost of threepence for each copy, post free.

4. The Authority are prepared to receive and consider any objection to the proposed Regulations. Any such objection should be in writing, and sent to the Authority at the address given below in order to reach them not later than the 28th day of April, 1952.
