TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (Cornwall) (No. 1) Order, 1952" authorising the stopping up of a footpath at Farmers Meadow, Newlyn, Penzance, in the County of Cornwall and requiring the provision of a new footpath.
