

place of abode and place of business, with the local authority and must keep a record of all his transactions. Officers of the local authority or other person duly authorised by the local authority will have free access at all reasonable times to the place of business or place of deposit of materials to inspect them and the books. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this section shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £5 and to a daily penalty not exceeding £2.

The order is dated 23rd June, 1952, and may be cited as "The Old Metal Dealers (No. 3) Order, 1952".
