The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 3, 1953.

(Made 16th January, 1953.)

1. Contracts, as from 22nd January, 1953, the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Crawcrook, Ryton, Co. Durham, declared by Special Order No. 1, 1953, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Crawcrook.

2. Releases such contracted Infected Area from restrictions on 29th January, 1953.

INCOME TAX.

Whereas it appears to the Commissioners of Inland Revenue that the number of persons appointed Commissioners for the General Purposes of the Income Tax Acts and persons to supply vacancies amongst such Commissioners for the Division of Staincliffe West in the West Riding of the County of York is insufficient for the proper discharge of the business therein arising under the aforesaid Acts, the said Commissioners of Inland Revenue in pursuance of the powers vested in them in that behalf hereby authorise the increase in the number of the Commissioners for the said Division to any number not exceeding Fourteen, and of persons to supply
