TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, authorising the stopping up of Hobbins Street, Monway Street, Brick Kiln Street, Foster Street, Paget Passage and lengths of Chapel Street and St. James Street at Wednesbury in the County of Stafford, and requiring the provision of four new roads repairable by the inhabitants at large, for which the highway authority is to be the Council of the Borough of Wednesbury.

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

DESTRUCTIVE INSECTS AND PESTS ACTS, 1877 TO 1927.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made Orders under the Destructive Insects and Pests Acts, 1877 to 1927, entitled "The Importation of Plants (Amendment) Order, 1953", and "The Importation of Lettuce from Southern France (General Licence) Order, 1953". These Orders are concerned with the conditions under which lettuce may be imported into England and Wales.

The first-named Order re-enacts the previous requirements relating to lettuce imported from countries outside Europe and makes new provisions relating to lettuce imported from Europe. For imports from Europe south of Latitude 46° N during the period 1st March to 15th October a Form A Certificate (as set out in the Third Schedule to the Importation of Plants Order of 1947) is required. For imports from Europe north of Latitude 46° N

during the month of March a certificate of origin is required and during the period 1st April to 15th October a Form A Certificate is required.

The General Licence relaxes for the month of March, 1953, the requirements of the above Order relating to the importation of lettuce from France south of Latitude 46° N by permitting a certificate of origin to be given instead of the Form A Certificate specified in the Importation of Plants Order of 1947.

Galvanised Sheets Price Adjustment Units.
