DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Order:—

Statutory Instruments 1953, No. 329.

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 17, 1953. (Made 2nd March, 1953.)

Declares an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 15 miles of Tadcaster, York-

shire, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of East, North and West Ridings of Yorkshire.

Copies of the above-mentioned Order may be obtained from the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, Animal Health Division, Hook Rise, Tolworth, Surbiton, Surrey.

We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the Ecclesiastical Commissioners Act, 1866, and of section two of the Church Commissioners Measure, 1947, do hereby grant out of our general fund to each of the benefices specified in the Schedule hereto one yearly sum or stipend of the amount stated opposite to the name of each benefice in the third column of the Schedule, such yearly sum or stipend to be calculated as from the date stated in the fifth column of the Schedule: Provided that the yearly sum or stipend so granted to a benefice shall, as from the said date, be in full substitution as regards that benefice for any temporary grant payable out of our general fund to the incumbent of that benefice and appearing in the fourth column of the said schedule opposite to the name of that benefice: Provided also that this Instrument which has been executed in several parts, one part for each diocese concerned, shall operate only as a single grant in favour of each of the benefices specified in the Schedule.
