EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department gives notice that he proposes to make a recommendation to Her Majesty that an Order in Council should be made amending proviso (iii) to paragraph (2) of Article 3 of Part I of the Order in Council dated the 27th day of November, 1875, made under the Explosives Act, 1875, and relating to stores licensed for mixed explosives, as amended by Article 3 of the Stores for Explosives Order, 1951.

The proposed amendment would affect certain stores existing at the date when the last-mentioned Order came into operation, and relates to distances between the stores and protected works.
