SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (DEFENCE PURPOSES) ACT,  
1951.

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice of his intention to make an Order under s. 2 (1) of the Supplies and Services (Defence Purposes) Act, 1951, the effect of which will be to authorise the stopping up of the following lengths of three roads at the Royal Air Force Station, Shepherds Grove, in the Parish of Bardwell, in the Rural District of Thingoe and the Parish of Walsham le Willows in the Rural District of Thedwastre, in the County of West Suffolk:—

1. Those lengths of the road leading from a point on Posters Lane approximately 534 yards south-east of Packclose Lane to Summer Road which extend (i) from a point approximately 670 yards north-east of its junction with Posters Lane in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 170 yards, and (ii) from a point approximately 1,020 yards north-east of its junction with Posters Lane in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 150 yards.

2. That length of King's Lane which extends from its junction with the road described in paragraph 1 in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 80 yards.

3. That length of Reading's Lane which extends from its junction with the road described in paragraph 1 in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 450 yards.

The said Order will be made not less than 21 days after the publication of this Notice.

A plan numbered SH 9/39-2 and marked "Highways at the Royal Air Force Station, Shepherds Grove in the County of West Suffolk" showing coloured red the highways to be stopped up may be inspected in Room No. 30, Ministry of Transport and Civil Aviation, Berkeley Square House, London, W.1, and at the Thingoe R.D.C.
