

respective dates set out in the fourth column of the said Schedule of all the endowments and other property belonging to each of the respective Sees set out in the first column of the said Schedule and described and referred to in the said Orders respectively and for the payment by the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners or the said Church Commissioners as the case may be to the Bishop for the time being of each of the respective Sees set out in the first column of the said Schedule of the annual stipend set out in the fifth column of the said Schedule together with such further sum not exceeding in any one year the sum mentioned in the Order relating to the said See as the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners or the said Church Commissioners as the case may be shall have been satisfied has been expended by the said Bishop in connection with the travelling required in and for the carrying out of his official duties and obligations as Bishop:

"Whereas it has been represented to us, the said Church Commissioners, and it appears to us to be expedient that the provisions of each of the Orders hereinbefore referred to should be altered as hereinafter recommended and proposed:

"And whereas we have prepared this Scheme accordingly after consultation with the Bishop and the Diocesan Board of Finance of each Diocese concerned who have offered no objection thereto:

"And whereas the Right Reverend Wilfred, Bishop of Blackburn, the Right Reverend Douglas, Bishop of Chester, the Right Reverend George, Bishop of Chichester, the Right Reverend Neville, Bishop of Coventry, the Right Reverend John, Bishop of Derby, the Right Reverend Percy, Bishop of Norwich, the Right Reverend Leslie, Bishop of Sheffield and the Right Reverend William, Bishop of Worcester, being in occupation of their respective Sees at the date of the passing of the aforesaid Measure have respectively appended their signatures to the Scheme in testimony of their approval:

"And whereas the Standing Committee of the Church Assembly has approved the Scheme:

"And whereas the Right Honourable Sir Winston Leonard Spencer Churchill, K.G., O.M., C.H., M.P.,

First Lord of Your Majesty's Treasury, acting on behalf of Your Majesty has signified to us his consent to the preparation and submission of the Scheme to Your Majesty in Council:

"Now, therefore, we, the said Church Commissioners do humbly recommend and propose to Your Majesty as follows, that is to say:

"(1) That the provisions of the said Order dated the 4th day of October, 1951 shall be altered in the following manner, that is to say, that in lieu of the annual stipend of Two thousand five hundred pounds now paid by us the said Church Commissioners we shall pay to the Bishop for the time being of the See of Chelmsford as from the 1st day of October, 1953 an annual stipend of Two thousand seven hundred pounds together with a further sum equal to the yearly rent payable by the Bishop as occupier of any house or part of a house let by us to the Bishop as the episcopal house of residence of the See out of which said annual stipend the Bishop shall defray all the expenses incurred by him in connection with the travelling required in and for the carrying out of his official duties and obligations as Bishop.

"(2) That the provisions of the Orders the respective dates of which are set out in the second column of the said Schedule shall each be altered in the following manner, that is to say, that in lieu of the annual stipend set out in the fifth column of the said Schedule we the said Church Commissioners shall pay to the Bishop for the time being of each of the respective Sees set out in the first column of the said Schedule as from the 1st day of October, 1953 an annual stipend of Two thousand two hundred pounds together with a further sum equal to the yearly rent payable by the Bishop as occupier of any house or part of a house let by us to the Bishop as the episcopal house of residence of the See and also such sum not exceeding in any one year the sum mentioned in the Order relating to the said See as we shall have been duly satisfied has been expended by the Bishop in connection with the travelling required in and for the carrying out of his official duties and obligations as Bishop.
