Thorpe Diversion (Revocation) Order.

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 14 of the Special Roads Act, 1949, to revoke the Birmingham—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (Thorpe Diversion) Order, 1938, which provided for the construction of a diversion between Norwich and Blofield in the county of Norfolk to supersede a length of the Birmingham—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road.

Diseases of Animals Act, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Order:—

Statutory Instruments 1954 No. 560.

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 17, 1954 (Made 27th April, 1954).

1. Declares an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Aldermaston, Reading, Berkshire, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of Berks and Southampton.

2. Permits pigs to be sent to a slaughterhouse or bacon-factory in the Infected Area with a licence issued by an Inspector of the Local Authority for the district from which the pigs are moved. Licences issued under this Order do not require counter-signature and may be granted only on production of a Ministry of Food delivery advice note.
