COAST PROTECTION ACT, 1949.

CEMAES RURAL DISTRICT (PWLLGWAELOD AND CWMYREGLWYS) COAST PROTECTION, ORDER, 1953.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government, on the 18th day of June, 1954, confirmed with modification the Order made by the Rural District Council of Cemaes applying the provisions of section 18 of the Coast

Protection Act, 1949, to the portion of the seashore described in the Schedule to this notice. The effect of the Order is to prohibit, save under licence, the excavation or removal of materials from any portion of the seashore to which the provisions of the said section are applied. The effect of the modification of the Order is that the provisions of subsection (1) of the said section 18 of the Coast Protection Act, 1949, shall not apply to the carrying out by the South West Wales River Board of any operation in or upon the said portions of the seashore in the exercise of any of their functions under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, and the River Board Act, 1948, or any amendment thereof.
