Croydon Development Plan.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 19th day of June, 1954, the Minister of Housing and Local Government approved with modifications the above Development Plan.

A certified copy of the Development Plan as approved by the Minister has been deposited at the Borough Engineer's Department, Town Hall, Croydon, and will be open for inspection free of charge by all persons interested between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 5.15 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and 8.45 a.m. and 12.15 p.m. on Saturdays.

The Development Plan becomes operative as from the 30th day of July, 1954, but if any person aggrieved by the Development Plan desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Development Plan, he may, within six weeks from the 30th day of July, 1954, make application to the High Court.

NOTICE is hereby given that the London County Council has issued a Direction dated 18th May, 1954, which has been approved subject to modification by

the Minister of Housing and Local Government prohibiting any development of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto in areas bounded by Camberwell New Road, the boundary between 127 and 129, Camberwell New Road, the rear boundary of Nos. 2 to 20 (even), Dugdale Street, Ivan Place, Warham Street, Hillingdon Street, Farmer's Road and John Ruskin Street, situate in the Metropolitan Borough of Lambeth and shown verged black on the map annexed thereto unless permission therefor is granted on an application made in that behalf under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950.

THE SCHEDULE referred to.

1. Development comprising the enlargement, improvement or other alteration of a dwelling house.

2. The provision, rearrangement or replacement of private ways or private railways, sidings or conveyors or the provision or rearrangement of sewers, mains, pipes, cables or other apparatus or the installation or erection by way of addition or replacement of plant or machinery or structures or erections of the nature of plant or machinery or the extension or alteration of buildings being development for industrial purposes.

3. The rebuilding, restoration or replacement of buildings, works or plant which have sustained war damage, being development comprised respectively within Classes I (1), VIII (1) (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) and XII referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development of any other class.
