The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to approve the award of the British Empire Medal (Military) to the undermentioned airman:

79272 Leading Aircraftman William Henry Andrews, Royal Air Force, Royal Air Force William 4079272 Leading Station, Binbrook.

On 2nd April, 1954, a Canberra aircraft, while taking off from Royal Air Force Station, Bin-brook, went out of control and crashed, striking the Ground Controlled Approach vehicles. One fuel tank was torn off and hurled into a truck where it exploded and threw burning paraffin all over the site. This truck was immediately ablaze and, within seconds, the permanently attached Ground Controlled Approach Prime Mover, which was less than ten feet away, also caught fire. The wreckage of the aircraft was scattered around and the situation was confused and dangerous. and the situation was confused and dangerous. and the situation was confused and dangerous. The whole site was covered with paraffin and burning fiercely around and under the vehicles. Leading 'Aircraftman Andrews, immediately appreciating the threat to the main Ground Controlled Approach installation, ran through the flames, climbed into the cab of the burning Prime Mover, backed out of the blaze and helped to extinguish the fire. This airman showed remarkable discipline and disregard for personal safety in a potentially highly dangerous situation. His prompt, cool-headed and brave action undoubtedly resulted in the saving of valuable and irreplaceable equipment. irreplaceable equipment.
