exceeds 28s. 0d. a day on the day before promotion, they are to enter the scale at the point corresponding to that total. But where the total of their ratings' emoluments does not exactly equal a point in the Branch Officers' scale they are to enter the scale at the point immediately above the total. Officers to proceed by way of normal increments from their point of entry to the maximum of 33s. 0d. a day.
