Order for the diversion of a public footpath leading off Birdhall Lane, Cheadle Heath, Cheshire.

Footpath Diversion Order (No. 1) 1954.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 28th day of October, 1954, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land situate in the Adswold Ward of the Urban District of Cheadle and Gatley.

The effect of the Order will be to extinguish part of the existing public footpath commencing at the south-eastern corner of the site of the dairy premises occupied by the Stockport Co-operative Society Limited in Birdhall Lane, Cheadle Heath, and running in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 1,050 feet or thereabouts as shown on the map attached to the Order between the points "A" and "B" and thereon coloured brown and to create in substitution therefor a new public footpath commencing at a point on Birdhall Lane approximately 460 feet to the north of the before-mentioned south-eastern corner of the said dairy premises and running in a westerly direction for a distance of 800 feet or thereabouts and thence in a southerly direction for a distance of 550 feet or thereabouts to the said point on the existing public footpath lettered "A" as shown on the map referred to between the points "C", "D", "E" and "A" and thereon coloured purple the length of such new public footpath being 1,350 feet or thereabouts.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Town Hall, Bruntwood, Cheadle, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and on Saturdays between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12 o'clock noon.

Any objection or representation with reference to the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, before the 13th day of December, 1954, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
