The Import Duties (Drawback) (No. 9) Order, 1954, which provides for the allowance of drawback of customs duty on horn matchet handles and parts thereof when these articles (or matchets incorporating them) are exported or shipped as stores.

GOVERNMENT ANNUITIES ACT, 1929
(19 and 20 Geo. 5).
