URBAN DISTRICT OF MYNYDDISLWYN.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

BY the Mynyddislwyn Urban District (Public Health) Order, 1955, (S.I. 1955 No. 228) the Minister of Housing and Local Government has declared that as from the 8th day of February, 1955, the following sections of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the Urban District of Mynyddislwyn:—

- Section 19 (Urgent repairs to private streets).
- Section 20 (Recovery of damages caused to footways by excavations).
- Section 28 (Removal of materials in streets).
- Section 29 (Deposit of building materials or excavations not to be made without consent).
- Section 30 (Dangerous places to be repaired or enclosed).
- Section 32 (Hoards to be securely erected).
- Section 33 (Exemption of buildings of railway companies and others):

Provided that nothing in section 30, as put in force by this Order, shall apply to any wall or other structure so far as it is used—

- (a) for the support of any street or public footpath repairable by the inhabitants at large, or
- (b) for the protection of any such street or footpath from damage or obstruction by reason of its
