

**NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE

Survey of Rights of Way.

THE Hampshire County Council in exercise of their duty under Part IV of the above Act, hereby give notice that they have prepared Provisional Maps and Statements under section 30 of the Act in respect of those parts of the County within the City of Winchester, the Borough of Eastleigh and the Rural District of Winchester.

Copies of the Provisional Maps and Statements have been deposited at the office of the County Surveyor, The Castle, Winchester, and at the offices of the persons indicated below, where they may be seen during the usual office hours:—

City of Winchester—

The Town Clerk, The Guildhall, Winchester.

Borough of Eastleigh—

The Town Clerk, Town Hall, Eastleigh.

Rural District of Winchester—

The Clerk of the Rural District Council,
45, Romsey Road, Winchester.

The Divisional Surveyor, The Chalk Pits,
Twyford.

For the convenience of the public, extracts from the Provisional Maps and Statements relating to each rural Parish are in the possession of Clerks of the respective Parish Councils or, in those cases where the Parish has no Council, the Chairmen of the Parish Meetings.

Any owner, occupier or lessee of land over which any of the paths run may apply to Quarter Sessions for the delation of any path from the Map or for any of the declarations referred to in section 31 of the Act. Applications to Quarter Sessions should be in writing and addressed to the Clerk of the Peace, The Castle, Winchester, and should reach him not later than the 31st May, 1955. Applications should specify the land to which the application relates, the grounds upon which the application is made and the name of the Surveying Authority

(i.e. The Hampshire County Council). The applicant should serve a copy of such notice upon every owner, lessee or occupier of the land and of any other land with regard to which the Court may make a declaration, and upon the Surveying Authority. Applicants should consult the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952 (S.I. 1952 No. 559) and sections 29 to 31 of the above Act.
