The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 20th day of *May*, 1955, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for (1) altering the boundaries of the parishes of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole* and *Leigh* and (2) altering the names of these parishes, both of which parishes are in the diocese of *Salisbury*.

"SCHEME.

"Whereas we are satisfied that it is desirable that the boundaries of the said parishes should be altered in the manner hereinafter mentioned:

"And whereas it has been represented to us, and it appears to us that the names of the parishes of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole*, and *Leigh* should be altered as hereinafter recommended and proposed:

"And whereas the Right Reverend *William*, Bishop of *Salisbury*, consents to the proposed arrangements (in testimony whereof he has signed this Scheme):

"Now, therefore, we do humbly recommend and propose to Your Majesty as follows:

"From and after the day of the date of publication in the *London Gazette* of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme—

(1) the boundaries of the said parishes of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole*, and *Leigh*, shall be altered in the manner described in the Schedule and delineated on the map annexed to this Scheme,

"(2) with the consent of the parochial church council of the said parish of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole*, and with the consent of the parochial church council of the said parish of *Leigh* (in testimony whereof this Scheme is signed by the Chairman of and two other members present at a meeting of each council duly convened for the purpose of giving such consent) the name of the parish of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole* shall be altered to '*The Parish of Yetminster*' and the name of the parish of *Leigh* shall be altered to '*The Parish of Leigh with Chetnole*'.

"SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be annexed to the parish of *Leigh*:—

"All that part of the parish of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole* which is bounded upon the east by the parish of *Leigh*, upon the south by the parish of *Melbury Bubb*, on the west by the parish of *Stockwood* and on the north by an imaginary line commencing on the boundary which divides the parish of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole* from the parish of *Stockwood* at the southwestern end of the wall or fence which forms the northwestern boundary of *Close Number 296* and continuing thence northeastwards along the last mentioned wall or fence to its end and in a straight line in continuation thereof to a point in the middle of the road which leads from *Yetminster* to *Chetnole* and continuing thence southeastwards along the middle of the last mentioned road to a point opposite the southwestern end of the wall or fence which forms the northern boundary of *Close Number 277* and continuing thence eastwards to and along the last mentioned wall or fence to its end and continuing thence southeastwards along the wall or fence which forms the northeastern boundary of the last mentioned close to its end and continuing thence in the same direction to the middle of an unnamed stream and continuing thence generally southwards along the middle of the last mentioned stream to a point opposite the northwestern end of the wall or fence which forms the southwestern boundary of *Close Number 293* and continuing thence southeastwards to and along the last mentioned wall or fence to its end and

continuing thence in the same direction to the northwestern end of the wall or fence which forms the southwestern boundary of close numbered 278 (thereby crossing the railway line of the *Wilts, Somerset and Weymouth Section of British Railways (Western Region)*) and continuing thence in the same direction along the last mentioned wall or fence and continuing thence northeastwards along the wall or fence which forms the southeastern boundary of the last mentioned close and continuing thence generally eastwards along the wall or fence which forms the northern boundary of *Close Number 291* to its end, and continuing thence eastwards to the northwestern end of the wall or fence which forms the northeastern and eastern boundary of *Close Number 290* (thereby crossing an unnamed stream) and continuing thence first southeastwards then southwards along the last mentioned wall or fence until it meets the wall or fence which forms the southeastern boundary of *Close Number 288*, and continuing thence northeastwards along the last mentioned wall or fence to its end, and in a straight line in continuation thereof to a point in the middle of *Herbury Lane* and continuing thence southwards along the middle of the last mentioned lane to a point opposite the boundary which divides the civil parish of *Chetnole* from the civil parish of *Yetminster* and continuing thence generally eastwards to and along the last mentioned boundary to the point where it meets the boundary which divides the parish of *Leigh* from the parish of *Yetminster* with *Chetnole*."

And whereas the provisions of the *New Parishes Measure, 1943*, relating to the preparation and submission of this Scheme, have been duly complied with:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by Her Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately upon the publication of this Order in the *London Gazette* pursuant to the said Measure.

And Her Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said diocese of *Salisbury*.

TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS.

1. 2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000 or £100,000. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Monday, the 20th June, 1955, to Saturday, the 25th June, 1955, inclusive, and will be due 91 days after date.
