TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, authorising the stopping up of a length of Pier Street Lane, Plymouth, and requiring the provision of a new road repairable by the inhabitants at large, for which the highway authority is to be the Plymouth C. and C.B.C.

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES AND FOOD

PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1937 AND 1948

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice, in pursuance of the above-named Regulations, that he hereby recognises the official certificate of which particulars are given in the schedule hereto as showing (a) that the meat product to which it relates was derived from animals inspected ante and post mortem and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister and (b) that all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to public health were taken in the preparing and packing of the meat product.

The certificate being in the form of a label or stamp, recognition will apply only if the label is securely affixed to, or the stamp is clearly impressed on, the container or package containing the meat product and the label or stamp has not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as an official certificate.

The certificate is of the same design as the one recognised on the 15th June, 1951, for the importation of canned meat products and other cooked meat products from Portugal.

For animal casings and lard, a label or stamp having on it the following design:—



The certificate will be completed by the insertion of the number of the factory and by the signature of the Chief of the Animal Health and Hygiene Department or his deputy.
