#### SCHEDULE.

VARIATIONS IN THE BY-LAWS OF THE ROYAL INSTITUTE OF CHEMISTRY REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING ORDER.

Delete existing By-laws 68 and 69 and substitute the following new By-Laws :---

"68. (1) At each Annual General Meeting the Council shall lay before the Institute in General Meeting the Annual Report of the Council on the affairs of the Institute, including Statements of Account made up to 30 September of the preceding year, showing the income and expenditure of the Institute for thet year

year, showing the income and expenditure of the Institute for that year. (2) The Statements so made up shall show, arranged under the most convenient heads, the amount of gross income, distinguishing the several sources from which it has been derived, and the amount of gross expenditure, distinguishing the expense of the establishment, salaries and other

expense of the establishment, salaries and other matters. "69. A Balance Sheet at 30 September of each year shall be made out and laid before the Institute at the next following Annual General Meeting. Such Balance Sheet shall contain a summary of the assets and liabilities of the Institute, arranged under convenient heads, and shall be included with the Statements of Account in the Annual Report of the Council on the affairs of the Institute. Provided that at the first Annual General Meeting held after this By-law and the foregoing By-law 68 shall come into operation the Council shall lay before the Institute in General Meeting a Report of the Council, including Statements of Account for a period of nine months ending on 30 September of the preceding year and a Balance Sheet at that date."
