WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 6th day of October, 1955, in the words and figures following, that is to say:— "We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pur-suance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for altering the boundaries of the parishes of Greasley, Kimberley, Awsworth with Cossall and Nuthall, all in the diocese of Southwell.

" SCHEME

"Whereas we are satisfied that it is desirable that the boundaries of the said parishes should be altered in the manner hereinafter mentioned :

And whereas the Right Reverend Russell, Bishop

"And whereas the Right Reverend Russell, Bishop of Southwell, consents to the proposed arrangements (in testimony whereof he has signed this Scheme): "Now, therefore, we, the said Church Commi-sioners, humbly recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme the boundaries of the said parishes of Greasley, Kimberley, Awsworth with Cossall and Nuthall shall be altered in the manner described in the Schedule and delineated on the map annexed to this Scheme.

"THE SCHEDULE

"I. Territory to be annexed to the parish of

"I. Territory to be annexed to the parish of Greasley:— "(a) All that part (coloured pink on the map annexed hereto) of the parish of Kimberley which lies to the west of a line commencing on the boundary which divides the parish of Greasley from the parish of Kimberley at a point where it crosses the mineral railway which runs from New London Colliery to Bennerley Ironworks thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the said mineral railway to where it meets the northern boundary of a detached part of the parish of Awsworth with Cossall thence in a western boundaries of the said detached part of the parish of Awsworth with Cossall to where the latter again meets the said mineral railway thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the said mineral rail-way to where it meets the boundary which divides the parish of Kimberley from the parish of Awsworth with Cossall. "(b) All that portion (coloured red on the map

"(b) All that portion (coloured red on the map annexed hereto) of the detached part of the parish of Awsworth with Cossall which lies to the west of the middle of the mineral railway described in paragraph (a) above.

"II. Territory to be annexed to the parish of Awsworth with Cossall:---

"" All that part (coloured yellow on the map annexed hereto) of the parish of Kimberley which lies to the south and west of a line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Awsworth with Cossall from the parish of Kimberley in the middle of the mineral railway which runs from New London Colliery to Bennerley Ironworks where it crosses the unnamed brook or Ironworks where it crosses the unnamed brook or stream thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the last mentioned brook or stream to a point in the middle of the viaduct which carries the Pinxton Branch of British Railways (London Midland Region) over the last mentioned unnamed brook or stream extending thence in a south Midland Region) over the last mentioned unnamed brook or stream, extending thence in a south easterly direction along the middle of the last mentioned railway for a distance of 25½ chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of Awsworth Junction thence due south in a straight line to a point in the middle of the footpath leading to Awsworth on the boundary which divides the parish of Kimberley from the parish of Awsworth with Corsell with Cossall.

"III. Territory to be annexed to the parish of

Kimberley:— "(a) All those two detached parts (coloured purple on the map annexed hereto) of the parish of Awsworth with Cossall, excluding the portion described in paragraph I (b) above, which lie within the parish of Kimberley.

"(b) All that part (coloured green on the map annexed hereto) of the parish of Nuthall which lies to the north and west of a line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Kimberley from the parish of Nuthall in the middle of Nottingham Road extending thence in an easterly direction along the middle of the last mentioned road to a point opposite the middle of the southern end of Larkfield Road and extending thence in a northerly direction to and along the middle of the last mentioned road to the boundary which divides the parish of Kimberley from the parish of Nuthall. parish of Nuthall.

thereof to he boundary which divides the parish of Kimberley from the parish of Greasley. "(b) All that detached part (coloured brown on the map annexed hereto) of the parish of Kimberley which is bounded on the east by the parish of Bulwell and on the remaining sides by the parish of Nuthall."
