The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (Middlesex) (No. 10) Order, 1955" authorising the stopping up of a length of the footpath leading from Old Church Lane to The Ridgeway, Stanmore, Middlesex and requiring the provision of a new footpath.
