Walton, Footpath Extinguishment Order.*

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order made on the 17th day of November, 1955, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land situate in the Parishes of Euxton and Ulnes Walton, in the County of Lancaster.

The effect of the Order will be to extinguish the public right of way leading from Dawbers Lane, Euxton, to Leyland Lane, Ulnes Walton.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Council Offices, Gillibrand Street, Chorley, and will be open for inspection, free of charge, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays, and 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays.

Any objection or representation with reference to the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, before the 20th day of December, 1955, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.

**CIRENCESTER RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL.**

*Cirencester Rural District Council (Ampney St.  
Peter O.S.9 Footpath) Diversion Order 1955.*

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 2nd day of November, 1955, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to divert the public right of way over the footpath running from the

North East corner of the field numbered 9 on the Ordnance Survey Map for the said Parish (1923 Edition) along the western side of the Eastern boundary wall of the said field to the South East corner thereof to a new line running from the North East corner of the said field along the Southern side of the Northern boundary wall to the North West corner of the said field and thence southwards along the Eastern side of the Western boundary wall to the South Western corner of the said field.

The old path will be closed as from the 23rd day of November 1955.

The width of the said new right of way will be five feet.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order as confirmed by the Minister has been deposited at the offices of the Cirencester Rural District Council, Dyer Street, Cirencester, and is available for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on any weekday excepting Saturdays and on Saturdays between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12 noon.

Any person who wishes to claim compensation as a result of the coming into operation of this Order should apply in writing to the Cirencester Rural District Council, Dyer Street, Cirencester, before the 18th day of April, 1956.

The Order became operative as from the date of publication of this Notice namely the 18th day of November, 1955, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this Notice make application to the High Court.
