Brenchley Parish. No. 82. B.R. to F.P. Spout Lane approx. 100 yards S.W. of Tawsden S. to Marle Place Road approx. 100 yards E. of the Warren.

Capel Parish. No. 1A. Road used as public path (C.R.F.) to F.P. The Postern S.E. and S. across railway to B 2017.

Capel Parish. No. 29 (part). Road used as public path (C.R.F.) to F.P. Alders Road approx. 120 yards S.E. of Barham House leading S. for approx. 200 yards.

Hadlow Parish. No. 63 (part). Road used as public path (C.R.B.) to B.R. From Shipbourne Parish boundary S.E. through Knight's Wood to junction S.W. of Shooting Lodge with added route.

Horsmonden Parish. No. 6. Road used as public path (C.R.F.) to F.P. Church N.W. under railway to Swigs Hole.
