DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Scotland acting jointly have made the following Orders:—

Statutory Instruments 1956 No. 55.

The Live Poultry (Essex) (Amendment) Order, 1956
(Made 17th January, 1956).

This Order, which came into operation on 19th January, 1956, enlarges the area described in the Live Poultry (Essex) Order, 1955, which prohibits the movement of poultry into, out of or within the area.

Statutory Instruments 1956 No. 56.

The Live Poultry (Mid-Lancashire) (Amendment) Order, 1956 (Made 17th January, 1956).

This Order, which came into operation on 19th January, 1956, reduces the area described in the Live Poultry (Mid-Lancashire) Order, 1955, which prohibits the movement of poultry into, out of or within the area.

Statutory Instruments 1956 No. 57.

The Live Poultry (Mid-Norfolk) (Amendment) Order, 1956 (Made 17th January, 1956).

This Order, which came into operation on 19th January, 1956, reduces the area described in the Live Poultry (Mid-Norfolk) Order, 1955, which prohibits the movement of poultry into, out of or within the area.

RIVER BOARDS ACT, 1948.

Severn River Board.

In pursuance of subsection (3) of section 6 of the River Boards Act, 1948, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food hereby gives notice that the Severn River Board have made application under the said subsection that the map approved under subsection (2) of the said section showing the extent of the main river for the purposes of Part II of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, be varied by the addition to the said main river of:—

(1) Part of the River Camlad from Hockleton Bridge about 1½ miles north-west of Chirbury on the Montgomery—Shrewsbury road to its confluence with the River Severn about 7 miles downstream of Welshpool, together with Gaer Mill race.

(2) Part of the River Morda from Newbridge about 3 miles south of Oswestry to Morton Bridge near Knockin, Shropshire.

(3) Part of the River Meese from Aqualate Mere 1½ miles north-east of Newport, Shropshire, to the confluence with Old Lonco Brook near Chetwyn.

(4) Part of Lonco Brook from Whitleyford Bridge about 3 miles north of Newport, Shropshire, to its confluence with the River Meese.

(5) Part of the River Alne from near Henley in Arden railway station to Wootton Bridge, Wootton Waven, Warwick, together with the by-pass channel at Blackford Corn Mill.

(6) Part of River Sherbourne from Whitley Bridge, London Road, Coventry, to Whitley Abbey Bridge, Coventry.

(7) Part of Piddle Brook from the bridge on the Worcester—Alcester road near Grafton Flyford to its confluence with the River Avon near Pershore, together with the corn mill race south of Grafton Flyford and the channel at Wyre Mill.

(8) Two un-named channels east of Peplow Hall about 6 miles south of Market Drayton, Shropshire.
