By Part III of the Second Schedule to the Land Drainage Act, 1930, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.

DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has made the following Order:—

Statutory Instruments 1956 No. 356.

*The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 6, 1956.*

(Made 13th March, 1956.)

Extends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around West Tisbury, Wilts., declared by Special Order No. 2, 1956, and contracted by Special Order No. 5, 1956, so as to include an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 10 miles of East Stour, Dorset.

Revokes Article 3 of Special Order No. 5, 1956.

Copies of the above-mentioned Order may be obtained from the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Hook Rise, Tolworth, Surbiton, Surrey.

We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the Ecclesiastical Commissioners Act, 1866, and of section 2 of the Church Commissioners Measure, 1947, do hereby grant, subject as hereinafter mentioned, out of our General Fund to the incumbent of each of the benefices whereof the names and the names of the dioceses wherein the same are respectively situate are stated in the first two columns of the schedule hereto, and to his successors incumbents of the same benefice, one yearly sum or stipend of the amount stated in the third column of the said schedule opposite to the name of the benefice, such yearly sum or stipend to be calculated as from the date stated in the fourth column of the said schedule opposite to the name of the benefice, and to be payable in equal quarterly portions on the 1st day of January, the 1st day of April, the 1st day of July and the 1st day of October in each and every year; Provided that such yearly sum or stipend is granted upon the condition that the diocesan board of finance shall bring the total net yearly stipend of the incumbent from all sources to £550 or to the current diocesan minimum, whichever is the greater: Provided also that this Instrument which is intended to be executed in several parts (one part for each Diocese concerned) shall operate only as a single grant in favour of each of the benefices mentioned in the said schedule.
