Is Excellency the Lord Lieutenant is very cheerful and active in the entrance upon his Government heren and bath fate three days in each week in Council ever fince his coming hither, he hath lately fent forth a Proclamation, strictly requiring all Governours and Officers of the Army to repair to their Charges and Daties, and will not admit of any dis-

Pensation to the contrary.

Weymouth, Octob. 9. Yesterday arrived in this Road the Edgar, a ship belonging to North Yarmouth in company of the Golden Falcon and the Argier Merchani bound for London, they came from Legorn on the 7th of Septemb r, before whole departure thence, there arrived an English thip from Algiers, affirming, that Sir Thomas Allen came before that place on the fixth of August, and sending in his Boat, had began to Treat; that those of Algier had all their men of War in Port, except only three which are at a place called Bona, and seemed willing to make restitution of the Moneys formerly taken by some of their men of War out of an English ship bound for the E. Indies, but not agreeing to some other demands, twas not known what the Truce, which had been agreed to by both parties. The Edgar on her way homewards made a little stop at Tangier and affirms that the Emperour of Morecco had lent a party of 4000 Horfe to conduct His Excellency the Lord Henry Homas d to the City of Fez, who was accordingly fet forwards wi h his Train.

Romé; Sep. 21. On Monday last the Pope, with a great Train of the Princes and Nobility on Horleback, went in Devotion to give a visit to several Churches, and particularly to those of St Francis, St Austin, St Maries, and that of the Holy Ghost, where the facted Host was solemnly exposed, and Prayers made for the preservation of the City of Candia from the Ottoman forces; and afterwards returned to St Peters in the Vatican; but in passing the Bridge was pleased to spend some time in taking a view of the excellent Work railed by his Order, for the Ornament of the faid Brilge, confitting of Ten Angels, excellently cut in Marble by the most excellent Masters, each of them holding in their han 's a Representation of some of the My-

steries of the Passion of our Saviour.

Madrid, Sept. 16. We daily expect the recurn of the Confier lome days fince fent hence to Rome to inform the

Pope of the Nomination made by the Queen Regent of Den Luys Fernandez de Portocarero, Dedn of the Cathedral be prompted to the Dignity of Cardinal, according to the Pope la e Concession in favour to the Crown of pain and of which, the Popes Declaration and Confiranation is accordingly expected, as is also the Resignation of the Inquisinorship by Fatter Nithard, which Charge tras pleated the Queen to confer upon Don Diego de

Valiadares, Bishop of Placenza and President of Castille : besides the conferring of these Honours, she has been likewife pleafed to bestow the Charge of General of the Gallies belonging to the Kingdom of Naples (which is lately become void by the Refignation of Don Fannetino Deria) upon the Duke de Ferandino, who lately commanded the Gallies of Sicily, whose vacant Charge of General of those Gallies, is disposed of to the Marquis de Cassanajete, Son to the Cardinal de Moncada.

The Marquis de Caffel Rodrigo begins to recover from his indisposition, which for some time rendred him uncapable, of entring into possession of the Charge of Master of the Horse to the Queen.

The King enjoyshis Health to the great fatisfaction of the Queen Regent, with the whole Court and Kingdom, and goes often abroad in publick, especially to the several Churches in this City, to satisfy the people with the view

of his person.

Great search has been made by the Queens special Command after the persons guilty of the Robbery committed in the Kings Chamber of a Cabinet wherein were laid up divers Letters of private and great concernment, but as yet no discovery can be made, the intention of the Robhers are the more apprehended in that they left behind feveral Jewels and things of value, and took away only the Papers.

Don foseph d' Ormaitche who was designed to have been fent into Flanders as Surintendent or Veedor Goneral of the Province, is lately dead, and as yet no other person nominated in his Roome. Several persons the most confiderable amongst the Nobility of the Nether ands have been lately nominated to be admitted into the Honorablé Society of the Knights of the Golden Fleete, and parti-

cularly the Marquis de Trescanie.

We have late advices from the Coasts of Affrica that the Moors which had blocked up the Fort of Oran, had quitted their design of laying a close sitge to it, and were marched cff to a greater distance, upon Intelligence given them that the Duke d' Alcala General of the Coasts of Andalusia had reinforced the Garrison with a confiderable number of fesh and able Souldiers, and a proportionable quantity of Provisions and ammunition.

Lisbonne Septemb. 25. Here is lately Iffued out a Preclamation from the Prince of Portugal Suicely Enjoyning all Officers and Souldiers which leaved in the late war of Spain to repair to the Frontiers, where they are to be admitted to the same Employments and Commands, which they had before the late peace, and for their Encouragement, papers are affixed in publick places to give them notice that the Prince will make them an allowance for ammunition tread, as was formerly used to be given them in time of War, which will will them. yield them a sublistance till moneys shall be raised to pay them their arrears.
