The Additional Import Dúties (No. 3) Order, 1956, which increases the rate of duty chargeable under the Import Duties Act, 1932 (a) on fruit stocks of Malling varieties, from £1 per cwt. or 5 per cent. ad valorem (whichever is the less), to £2 5s. Od. per cwt., and (b) on certain species of palms, from 10 per cent. ad valorem to £2 5s. Od. per cwt.
