Major (temp.) John Anthony LLOYD-WILLIAMS (328002), 2nd King Edward VII's Own Gurkha Rifles (The Sirmoor Rifles).

Major Lloyd-Williams has seen several years of active service in command of a Company engaged in operations against Terrorists in Malaya. He has demonstrated unflagging zeal and determination to pursue and destroy the enemy. He has on several occasions displayed personal gallantry of a high order, under fire. He has conducted relentless and skilful pursuits in the jungle for days on end and has personally led his men when assaulting Terrorists' positions in the face of heavy fire. His example has been an inspiration to the men of his Company whose morale remains very high in spite of several years of operations. of several years of operations.

Captain (Q.G.O.) DAMBERSING RAI (388562), 10th Princess Mary's Own Gurkha Rifles.

This Gurkha Captain has taken part in many operations against the Terrorists in Malaya during the past seven years. His fine leadership and personal determination to close with the enemy has earned him a high reputation. He has conducted skilful reconnaissances in the jungle and led his men with speed and determination against located Terrorists. He has pressed home attacks in the face of heavy fire and has led his men with success in close quarter fighting. in close quarter fighting.

## Distinguished Conduct Medal.

DN 24368 Warrant Officer, Platoon Commander KENNEDY TIFINENI, Northern Rhodesia Regiment.

Warrant Officer Platoon Commander Kennedy Tifineni has throughout operations since October, Tifineni has throughout operations since October, 1954, shown outstanding qualities of leadership. On one occasion when his Platoon Commander was killed he immediately took over, rallied the Platoon and pressed home the assault against a Communist Terrorist camp. During this attack his conduct was quite fearless. In the subsequent action he located three Terrorists, one armed with a Sten gun. Without hesitation he engaged them personally killing one and putting the other two to flight. He has displayed much gallantry and inspired his men by his example.

## Military Medal.

21137159 Sergeant (acting) PARTAPSING RAI, 7th Gurkha Rifles.

Sgt. Partapsing Rai has been employed on operations against the Communist Terrorists for the operations against the Communist Terrorists for the past three years. He has spent long periods leading small parties in the jungles and swamps under the most arduous conditions. In particular he displayed patience, determination and tactical skill in the successful staging of an ambush which entailed a long wait of two days and nights in cramped positions exposed to the heat of the sun by day and the damp chill of the night. The success of this ambush was undoubtedly due to the courage and leadership of Sgt. Partapsing Rai.

21135185 Corporal (acting) Indrabahadur Gurung, 6th Gurkha Rifles.

Early in January, 1956, this N.C.O.'s Section was leading a search for Terrorists through most difficult mountainous country. Contact was made with outposts guarding a Terrorist camp of 40 men. Although fired on from a flank, Cpl. Indrabahadur Gurung put the outposts to flight and pressed on into the main camp. Still under fire he was the first man to reach the main camp where he personally engaged the Terrorists. He displayed great powers of leadership and personal courage of a high order in this attack.

21141433 Corporal (acting) GUNDABAHADUR RAI, 10th Princess Mary's Own Gurkha Rifles.

Cpl. Gundabahadur Rai has been on operations against the Terrorists for seven years. He has built up for himself a reputation for courage, leadership and gallantry in the face of the enemy. He has led his men through heavy fire to assault Terrorists positions. He has shown great personal courage and determination during jungle patrols, and has been successful on many occasions in putting dangerous Terrorists out of action. His fearless devotion to duty has been an example to his men. Cpl. Gundabahadur Rai has been on operations his men.
