WAITING RESTRICTIONS.

Borough of Walthamstow.

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation in accordance with the London Traffic Act, 1924, section 10, as amended, proposes to refer to the London and Home Counties Traffic Advisory Committee for their advice and report a proposal that he should make Regulations to prohibit waiting by vehicles on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:—

(A) between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m in St. Mary Road, Walthamstow, from a point 45 feet from its junction with Hoe Street to its junction with Stainforth Road.

Exemptions will be provided in the Regulations to permit vehicles to wait—to pick up and set down passengers, to load and unload goods, to carry out essential services, or while in use by local authorities in an emergency.)

(B) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on one side of the street on alternate days, or on the other side for more than 30 minutes in any period of 60 minutes, in Pretoria Avenue, Walthamstow, from its junction with Maude Road to its junction with High Street.

(Exemptions will be provided in the Regulations to permit vehicles to wait on either side of the street—to pick up and set down passengers, to carry our essential services, or while in use by local authorities in an emergency.)

DISEASES OF IANIMALS ACT, 1950.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 85 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1950, that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Scotland acting jointly have made the following Order:—

Statutory Instruments 1957 No. 170.

The Exported Cattle Protection Order, 1957. (Made 6th February, 1957.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 26th February, 1957, requires that any cattle which are to be exported from Great Britain to any place outside the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man or the Republic of Ireland, whether by sea or by air, shall be rested for at least ten hours before they are loaded in the ship or aircraft in which they are to be carried. It requires the provision of adequate food and water, and, in winter, shelter and bedding, and also empowers an inspector appointed by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food or by the local authority to prohibit the carriage of any animal, or to requre an animal to be removed from the ship or aircraft if it is likely to be exposed to unnecessary suffering during transit.
