TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

The Prohibition of Landing of Animals, Carcasses and Animal Products, and Hay and Straw from the Channel Islands (Revocation) Order, 1957

(Made 17th April, 1957.)

This Order, which came into operation on 19th April, 1957, revokes the Prohibition of Landing of Animals, Carcasses and Animal Products, and Hay and Straw from the Channel Islands Order, 1957, which prohibited the landing in Great Britain of animals, carcasses, animal products, and hay and straw from the Channel Islands (other than Jersey).
