WHEREAS the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 1st day of November, 1957, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—
"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for (1) altering the boundaries of the parishes of Chigwell Row and The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford, and (2) constituting a new parish to be taken out of the parishes of The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford; Trinity, Barkingside; Chigwell and Chigwell Row, all of which parishes are situate in the diocese of Chelmsford.

"SCHEME.

"Whereas we, the Church Commissioners, are satisfied (1) that it is desirable that the boundaries of the parishes of Chigwell Row and The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford, should be altered in the manner described in Part I of the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed; and (2) that the spiritual interests of the area defined schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed; and (2) that the spiritual interests of the area defined in Part II of the said Schedule and delineated on the said map would be best served by constituting it a new parish and that a suitable endowment therefor will be provided:

"And whereas we have not approved any consecrated church within the area described in Part II of the said Schedule as suitable to be the parish

secrated church within the area described in Part II of the said Schedule as suitable to be the parish church of the new parish:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Falkner, Bishop of Chelmsford (in testimony whereof he has set his hand and affixed his episcopal seal to this Scheme), we, the said Church Commissioners, do humbly recommend and propose as follows, that is to say:—

"1. As from the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme the boundaries of the said parishes of Chigwell Row and The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford, shall be altered in the manner described in Part I of the Schedule hereto and delineated on the map amexed hereto.

"2. (a) As from the date of the licence hereto of a Minister the area defined in Part II of the said Schedule and delineated on the said map shall be a separate district for spiritual purposes.

"(b) As from the date of the consecration of a church within the area approved by us, the said Church Commissioners, as suitable to be a parish church, or if the church is consecrated before such approval, the date of the approval, the said area shall become a new parish.

"(c) The name of the district (or parish as the case may be) shall be 'the District (or Parish) of Saint Paul, Hainault'.

"3. Archdeaconry and Rural Deanery. The parish shall be in the Archdeaconry of West Ham and in the rural deanery of Chigwell.

"All that part (coloured pink on the map annexed hereto) of the parish of The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford, which lies generally to the northwest of a continuous imaginary line which commences on the boundary which divides the parishes of Lambourne and The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford, at the northern end of the boundary which separates closes numbered 4, 4i, 6c and 6i, from closes numbered 6, 6u and 6b on the said map and proceeds thence generally southwards and southwestwards along the last mentioned boundary to the southernmost point of close boundary to the southernmost point of close number 4; thence northwestwards and southwestwards along the northeastern and northwestern boundaries of closes numbered 6a and 59; thence northwestwards along the middle of Romford Road, southwestwards along the middle of Fowler Road, northwestwards along the middle of Beaver Road, southwestwards along the middle of Peregrine Road, northwestwards along the middle of Falconer Road and Huntsman Road, southwest-
