Swaton Footpath No. 5 Extinguishment Order, 1957.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 22nd day of November, 1957, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed, with modifications, the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to extinguish the public right of way from a point running from West Street, Swaton, north-eastward through Fields O.S. Nos. 149, 130, 124 and 122 to Helpringham Road, Swaton. The footpath will be closed at the expiration of

14 days from the date of the publication of this notice.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order as confirmed by the Minister, has been deposited at the Council Offices, 18, Northgate, Sleaford, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays and from 9 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays.

The Order becomes operative as from the 29th day of November, 1957, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the National
