NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949.

Rural District Council of Deben (Parishes of Eyke and Rendlesham No. 1). Extinguishment Order, 1958.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 2nd day of January, 1958, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order relates to land situate in the Parishes of Eyke and Rendlesham.

The effect of the Order will be to extinguish the public right of way running from the termination of a lane leading to Nos. 1 and 2, Church Lane, Rendlesham from St. Gregory's Church in a West South Westerly direction for a distance of approximately 120 yards to the Rendlesham/Eyke Parish Boundary and continuing in a similar direction in the Parish of Eyke for approximately 347 yards to the South West corner of Ordnance Survey enclosure numbered 351 then turning in a South Westerly direction for approximately 273 yards terminating on the road opposite Low Farm, Eyke.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Council Offices, Melton Hill, Woodbridge, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekdays and 9 a.m. to 12 noon Saturdays.

Any objection or representation with reference to the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, before the 10th day of February, 1958, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
