

CATERING WAGES ACT, 1943.

LICENSED NON-RESIDENTIAL ESTABLISHMENT WAGES BOARD.

The Licensed Non-residential Establishment Wages Board hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour and National Service proposals for increasing the statutory minimum remuneration for the wife of a Club Steward, set out in the Wages Regulation (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) (Managers and Club Stewards) Order, 1956 (Order L.N.R. (40)) as amended by the Wages Regulation (Licensed Non-residential Establishment) (Managers and Club Stewards) (Amendment) Order, 1957 (Order L.N.R. (44)).
