INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS  
 (IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT, 1950.

In pursuance of subsection (1) (c) of section 2 of the International Organisations (Immunities and Privileges) Act, 1950 (14 Geo. 6, Chapter 14), Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the list published in the London Gazette of January 8, 1957, as amended by notices published on January 8, 1957, November 12, 1957, and this day, of persons who are entitled to immunities and privileges conferred by the International Organisations (Immunities and Privileges of Western European Union) Order, 1955.

In respect of Article 12 of the said Order these amendments take effect in relation to each person, from the dates respectively indicated, being the dates as from which, for the purposes of the said Order, such persons ceased to hold the office or employment in question. In respect of Article 13 of the said Order the amendments take effect, in relation to each person from the date on which he or she completed his or her return journey from the place of meeting:
