Flight Sergeant Lees is in charge of the Mountain Rescue Team based at the Royal Air Force Station, Valley. At about 4.30 p.m. on 3rd January, 1958, the team was called upon to assist in the rescue of an army officer who was lying seriously injured 550 feet from the foot of Amphitheatre Buttress on Craig-yr-Ysfa in the Welsh mountains. Flight Sergeant Lees directed the team over snow covered rocks to the summit of Craig-yr-Ysfa, and at 7.30 p.m., in darkness, led four men down 750 feet of cliff to the place where the injured man lay. Below this point was 200 feet of vertical cliff, with overhang in places. Flight Sergeant Lees, with the injured man strapped to his back, and supported from above by a rope manned by the other members of the team, climbed down this 200 feet of cliff to a waiting stretcher. Although exhausted by the tremendous physical strain imposed on him he refused to give in and not only directed the movements of the stretcher party but also bore the brunt of the carrying duties during the descent of Cwm Aigian. Flight Sergeant Lees, with no thought for his own safety, showed exceptional skill, courage and determination during this hazardous operation. hazardous operation.
