

COAL ACT, 1938 AND COAL INDUSTRY NATIONALISATION ACT, 1946.

PURSUANT to paragraph 6 (2) of the Second Schedule to the Coal Act, 1938, the National Coal Board hereby given notice that they propose to exercise the right to withdraw support vested in them by virtue of Paragraph 6 (1) of the said Schedule and the Coal Industry Nationalisation Act, 1946, so far as the said right applies in relation to two parcels of land at North Wingfield Village containing approximately 0.5 acres and 18.5 acres respectively, situate as to the first plot, at the "Gate Inn" and adjoining thereto, and as to the second plot, at Little Morton Farm and extending to the East thereof, both in the Parish of North Wingfield in the county of Derby and indicated in red colour on a plan which is deposited and open for inspection at the offices of the National Coal Board, East Midlands Division, Sherwood Lodge, Arnold, near Nottingham.
