**EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

These Regulations amend the National Insurance  
(Airmen) Regulations, 1948, by extending the pro-  
visions of those regulations, which make exceptions  
from disqualification for receipt of sickness benefit  
by reason of absence from Great Britain, and by  
applying those provisions to certain persons who  
travel to commence employment as aircrew abroad.  
They provide that the provisions of those regula-  
tions which suspend payment of benefit to airmen  
while absent from Great Britain shall cease to have  
effect. The remaining alterations are of a minor  
and consequential character.
