The Chesterfield Rural District No. 1 (Holymoorside) Smoke Control Order, 1958.

1. Notice is thereby given that the Chesterfield Rural District Council in exercise of the powers conirdical District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 111 of the above-mentioned Act on the 5th day of June, 1958, made an Order entitled the Chesterfield Rural District No. (Holymoorside) Smoke Control Order, 1958, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Stubject to the exemptions provided by the Order 2. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity electricity.

3. Copies of the Order and of the majo referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at Rural Council House, Saltergate, Chesterfield, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 20th day of June, 1958.
