

of Order made—Discharge granted subject to suspension of two months and subject to the following conditions to be fulfilled before his discharge takes effect—namely, he shall, before the signing of this Order, consent to judgment being entered against him in the Nottingham County Court by the Trustee for the sum of £2,500 being part of the balance of the debts provable in the bankruptcy which is not satisfied at the date of this Order. And it is further ordered, without prejudice and subject to any execution which may be issued on the said Judgment with the leave of the court, that the said sum of £2,500 be paid out of the future earnings or after-acquired property of the bankrupt in the manner following, that is to say, the bankrupt shall pay £500 before the signing of this Order and within one month of the date of this Order and the balance at £20 a month commencing 24th June, 1958, to the Trustee for distribution among the Creditors in the bankruptcy.
